I am sure that you are missing our regular Gathering, Walks and time together as 4th Day members of EOEE. I assure you that you are NOT alone! Communities around the globe have stopped holding Gatherings for much of 2020. In fact, the total number of pilgrims globally in 2019 was 12, 580 and 1939 Butterflies. Before the pandemic this year there had been 4152 pilgrims and 665 Butterflies. That's a really big difference!! Emmaus Ministries is 100% funded through participant fees, merch sales and manual fees. Without walks, none of that income is earned. There is a projected deficit of \$165,000 this year. You can help by being a part of the 100 Days of Giving that started earlier this fall. Through your financial support, we can keep the doors open for our beloved Walk to Emmaus, Chrysalis, and Face to Face experiences when this pandemic allows us to meet again.
