#### GREETINGS FROM THE COMMUNITY LAY DIRECTOR



Hello Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

The new life of the season makes us glad that winter has finally passed. And, I especially love April when we have Walks to Emmaus happening just before we celebrate Resurrection Sunday. We are overjoyed by the powerful reminder of the new life Jesus bought for us with His life. We are awed once again by His Holy Presence with us! Praise be to God!

Welcome to all 27 women and men who completed Walks #99! We hope that your Fourth Day is satisfying and productive and

filled with new life! We pray that God is speaking to you in wonderful new ways and that you are able to apply all you learned from the weekend into your daily living. New creations, indeed! We look forward to seeing you all at the Gathering, May 21, 2022, at 6:00pm!

Allow me to bring you up to speed on what The East Ohio Emmanuel Emmaus Board is doing. At our last meeting, we continued our discussion about the new retreat called Day Four Restore. I am still looking for some volunteers to join a Task Force in developing this one-day retreat for members of the Fourth Day Community. Please watch for more information about Day Four Restore in the coming months. We are in the process of signing the annual Covenant with the Upper Room. It is a little more complicated this year as we familiarize ourselves with a new program they've rolled out world-wide. Ministry Manager helps keep all Emmaus Communities connected and gives us a universal system where we can place orders, send payments, announce Walk Weekends, and request prayers. We will be voting on Lay Leaders for Walks #102 next month and ask you to pray with us for God's hand to be on those eligible and those nominated. In September 2019, the Board decided to stop including a physical copy of the Weekend's group photo in the Take Home Packets. A link was provided to Pilgrims and Team to make a copy if desired (and one, of course, was printed for the archives). That policy was reviewed, found unacceptable, and the Board voted to reinstate placing a physical copy of the Weekend group photo in all Take Home Packets, though the photo will be smaller due to cost. And last, we realized that this year – 2022 – is the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the East Ohio Emmanuel Emmaus Community. Please see a separate note in the Newsletter asking for help in organizing this event.

As we each move forward in our lives and in our work for the Lord, especially when we question our decisions - as we allow God to cleanse us over and over and sanctify us more and more - we learn that the only way forward is through deep trust in Him. We must do what Jesus did in the Garden and say, "Not my will, but Thine be done," and *trust* that God's got us. He does, you know! It's hard! But God gives us the strength to persevere. I pray that you feel God's strength in you, even now! I pray for you all, that even if it's not going well with your circumstances, that it is well with your soul!
