GREETINGS FROM THE UPCOMING LAY LEADERS

So far, the team meetings for Men's Team 101 have gone well. The team is starting to gel, and my joy level is increasing by the day. Who would know this could be so much fun?

The next two Saturdays will be Talk Preview days. This is the team's chance to practice all things related to the weekend. If we are going to make mistakes, and we are, this is the time to make them and perfect the process.

The table leaders will be paired for the weekend and will practice leading tables at the second talk preview day.

All of this to prepare for the Pilgrims God will send. We do not know who these people are, but God does, and they are valuable to him. We intend to show them they are valuable to us as well.

Agape

Do you remember feeling blessed by a handwritten note or card from a Christian brother or sister you'd never met? Please consider passing it on by writing general agape for a pilgrim on the upcoming walks.

As a reminder, **General Agape** is given to the pilgrims in the first and second drops on Saturday at 3:21PM and 9:25 PM. **Personal Agape** from family and friends is delivered in the third drop on Sunday at 11:32 AM. All agape must fit into a paper “lunch size” bag. Please save any gifts or large items for the journey home.

Both General and Personal Agape can be dropped off at the Agape Room in Moody Retreat Center (lower level). Place your agape in the appropriate boxes no later than one hour before each drop to allow the team members ample time to sort and deliver. The Agape Room will close at 9 PM each evening so the team can rest and prepare to serve the pilgrims the following day. Please respect the teams' privacy during the weekends, and delivering agape only.

For your convenience, an Agape Box will be placed in the back of the barn on Saturday night during the Candlelight Service. You can place your Personal Agape (to be delivered in the third drop on Sunday) in this box rather than taking it to Moody Retreat Center.
