GREETINGS FROM THE LAY LEADERS

I came to East Ohio Emmanuel Emmaus in 1996, as a relatively new Christian, just learning to be a leader. That October weekend 36 team members and about 200 fourth day helped God change my life. Since then, I have wanted to be that life changing agent for everybody who God has placed in my path.

I went back to my church and before I said a word to anybody, my friend, who was watching me, said to my sponsor, I WANT THAT and that led to about twenty other people coming through EOEE. Those same 36 team members and 200 fourth day were used by God to change their lives: people they have never met. That is why we came here to Emmaus. That is why we sacrifice. That is what brings us more joy than we can contain. To spread agape love that pilgrims do not understand. Agape love that Jesus is most known for. We honestly love people the way Jesus does.

God entrusted me with this team and these pilgrims. AN AWESOME RESPONSIBILITY. I started by casting the vision for the team. God's vision.

But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness AND ALL THESE THINGS WILL BE ADDED TO YOU. A life verse for me. GOD HAS ADDED MORE TO ME THAN I COULD POSSIBLY UNDERSTAND. I walk this stuff every day. Trusting God, in every circumstance, seeking ONLY HIS WILL.

I told them if they seek the eternal, in all circumstances, not only will they get the eternal, but God will also give them every physical thing that it takes to fulfill HIS WILL, 100% of the time. They could trust him at his word and true revival could happen here. Shine a bright light. Be God's salt and light. RIGHT HERE.

I asked them what God was going to do through them so that a pilgrim on walk 101 would know that God loves them more than they could possibly understand.

Just like with me long ago, GOD USED THIS TEAM TO CHANGE THE LIVES OF PEOPLE THEY DID NOT KNOW. It did not take long for the pilgrims to realize we truly loved each other and them. The Holy Spirit moved in ways that most veteran team members were touched by. Most thanked God for allowing them to serve on this team. Many will refocus their purpose back to their churches. Yes, God can change team members too.

The pilgrims stated at closing their intent to go back to their churches and make that same difference.

Two tables talked about starting their own accountability groups. Some have already started.

The Saturday night entertainment broke into a praise session that was only stopped by Candlelight or it

might have gone on for hours. One of the pilgrims joined the singers and sang a few songs.

The fourth day, new and current, all-in unison, sang the theme song at closing, “Amazing Grace (my chains are gone)”. This time I just bounced up and down. It caused many tears during the Saturday night dinner.

I can hardly wait for a report from people over time. Our future is bright.
