As we prepare for Walk's #67, we ask you to remember the Pilgrim and Team members in your prayers, and that you shower them in God's love in the form of Agape. When preparing Agape, please remember the following things:

1. Please separate the Team and Pilgrims' agape. Write both first and last names.
2. Please do not write which drop the agape is for directly on the envelope. Use the wrapped boxes in agape room marked 1 2 or 3.
3. Please try to keep agape items to a minimal size, that will fit into an agape lunch bag. Any large items will be held and given to the sponsor at the end of the weekend.
4. Be sure to have all agape dropped off ONE HOUR before scheduled drop time.
5. Personal agape Drop #3 only.
6. If giving agape like a chain or necklace, please place each individual item in an envelope with each name marked.
7. Use special wrapped boxes in agape room marked 1, 2, or 3 drops.

DURING THE WEEKEND

1. See that your Pilgrim has transportation to and from the weekend.
2. Stay with your Pilgrim until he/she has settled in.
3. Send agape and remember to get a note from the spouse and family.
4. Attend chapel service for sponsors on Thursday, ecumenical service and candlelight on Saturday, and walk-in and closing on Sunday. At the Thursday evening chapel service and again at the service before candlelight, there is a time to pray for each one of the Pilgrims attending the Walk. It is your privilege to lift your Pilgrim in prayer at this time. If for some reason you are unable to attend these services, please make arrangements for someone else to pray for your Pilgrim. **PLEASE REFRAIN** from serving meals so that your pilgrim can concentrate on the weekend.
5. PRAY at home, and in chapel if possible.
6. While the mates are on the weekend, make sure the spouse has your phone number in case of an emergency. Be available to help if needed to keep the family from being lonely. You might invite them to lunch over the weekend, bake them something, or at least stay in touch by phone.

AFTER THE WEEKEND

1. Pray for their 4th Day!
 2. See that your Pilgrim is in a group reunion—joins a current one or perhaps starts a new one.
 3. Keep in touch with your Pilgrim and show as much interest and concern as you did before and during the weekend.
 4. Encourage regular church attendance and involvement in church activities.
- As you can see, it is a serious responsibility to sponsor a Pilgrim. God bless you for your sacrifice and willingness to serve in this way!
