Directions to the Noble's Farm

1. Exit 77 at Airport
2. North on Lauby Road
3. East on State Street
4. North on Market Avenue
5. East on Lake O'Pines (1st street on right)
6. 1154 (first drive on right)

This year's family picnic will be held at 1154 Lake O' Pines, south of Hartville. Dinner will be at 5:30 p.m. Bring a covered dish, (limited electricity), table service, drinks, especially bottled water, and lawn chairs. Musicians are encouraged to bring their instruments for a time of singing. Children welcome. Volleyball, tether ball, fishing (must put fish back), etc. weather permitting. **Children and folks who are not yet 4th day are welcome!**

Dear 4th Day,

We come to you to ask please begin to pray for these individuals who will be on the fall walks. Also, pray for their sponsors that they will fulfill their duties and responsibilities, and provide the support needed. (Gather personal agape, transport your pilgrim, attend Thursday sponsor's hour, Candlelight and Closing/help with any family needs of the pilgrim during the weekend. The EOEE board also encourages the 4th day that are NOT sponsoring to serve meals on the weekends. Pray to see if the Lord is leading you in this manner to serve.

Important Information about Walk Events:

Children

Children are welcome at monthly Fourth Day Gatherings where child care is provided. Children are **not to attend** weekend events at Camp Wanake. There are several reasons for this: Emmaus policy, liability issues, and for consideration of pilgrims who are away from their own children for three days.

Message about Agape:

We ask you to remember the Pilgrim and Team members in your prayers, and that you shower them in God's love in the form of Agape. When preparing Agape, please remember the following things:

1 Please separate the Team and Pilgrims' agape. Write both first and last names on the envelopes. Alphabetizing each if possible.

2 Please do not write which drop the agape is for directly on the envelope. Designate the Drop Number on a Post-it note or separate note if you wish it to be delivered in a certain drop.

3 Please try to keep agape items to a minimal size, that will fit into an agape lunch bag. Any large items will be held and given to the sponsor at the end of the weekend.

4 To ensure that your agape will be delivered at a specific drop, please be sure to have all agape dropped off ONE HOUR before the scheduled drop time.

5 Remember, Personal agape is to be delivered in Drop #3 only.

6 If you give an item, such as with a chain, please place each individual item in an envelope with each name marked. This will help prevent tangling. Thank You
