Monthly Gathering

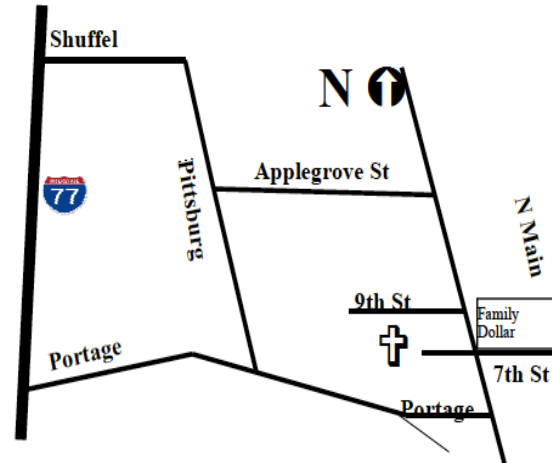

Please drop off your agape at the agape room 1 hour before the time of each drop to give us time to sort and deliver to the pilgrims. There will also be an agape box in the barn the night of the Candlelight Service for the 3rd drop. Remember any agape must fit the mail slots that we use to sort for each pilgrim. Please save any large gifts for the 4th Day journey home. The agape room will be closed at 9 pm each evening. Please respect the teams' privacy as they rest and prepare to serve the pilgrims the next day.
