## GREETINGS FROM THE COMMUNITY LAY DIRECTOR

### Board Position Descriptions:

**Walk:** Set up and tear down on weekends; Prepare for sendoff prayer service on Thursday and Candlelight service on Saturday

**Prewalk:** Correspond with sponsors in preparation for the walk; processing applications; keep track of the number of Pilgrims

**Secretary:**

- Takes minutes at board meetings
- Ensures minutes are distributed to members shortly after each meeting
- Maintains records of the board and ensures effective management of organization's records
- Is sufficiently familiar with legal documents (articles, by-laws, IRS letters, etc) to note applicability during meetings
- Assists Community Lay Director as needed

**Treasurer**

- Manages the checking and savings accounts
- Provide the board with a monthly report on financial standings and needs
- Authorizes the request for funds
- Prepares an annual budget for the Board

**Communications:** Monitor and distribute communications to the community via email; prayer chain; Facebook; website maintenance; newsletters. The three committee members rotate these responsibilities

**Postwalk:** Coordination and planning of gatherings and activities after the weekends

**Tech (2 positions available):** Manage the electronic prayer vigil and assist the chapel with it; make sure the teams following the licensing for music; maintain and update the song book; set up/tear down/pack away camp audio and video in the conference room and barn chapel; set up and run sound for gatherings
